Sermon Notes

Series: In Times Like These Sermon: "Desperate Prayer" Text: Psalm 5:1-3 Terry McIntosh

Introduction: Some are getting desperate in this pandemic. I like to define desperation as being at the end of your tether; being on the edge of despair. We need to realize that there is such a thing as prayer... and then there is such a thing as desperate prayer. When desperation sets in, believers are to resort to God rather than the machinations of the world in order to "find answers" or to "cope". Note four terms that help us define desperate prayer:
