

Date: January 24, 2021 Sermon: "The Freedom of Our Chains" Text: Philippians 1:12-18

Introduction: Attitude is everything. Attitude is the manner, disposition, feeling, position, etc. with regard to person or thing, a tendency or orientation especially of the mind. An ungodly, un-gospel, attitude affects many believers. Paul's life attitude was "*I don't mind chains, as long as the gospel is advanced*" (v. 12-14). Note *four ways* Paul's attitude toward his "*chains*" advanced the gospel:

I. His ______ was established (v. 13 "...for Christ")

II. It gave him the ______ to be a ______ for Christ (v. 13b "...*it has become known*..." - "*clear*" in the NIV)

III. The gospel went to ______ it _____ would not have gone (v. 13c "...the whole imperial guard")

IV. Christians were ______ to _____ for Christ (v. 14)
