Sermon Title: The Sustaining Vision of John

Sermon Text: Revelation 4:1-5:14

Sermon Truth: The church should immerse itself in John's heavenly throne room vision, because through such immersion it will be

steeled to endure any hardship in this life.

Transition: In John's vision of the heavenly throne room, we see two beings meant to steel our endurance as God's people.

Being Number One - The One Seated on the Throne who is Holy

- A. He isn't, nor can He be made in our image.
- B. He receives the praise of holy and powerful creatures.
- C. He comfortably rules over the chaos of this life.

Being Number Two - The Conquering Lion who is a Lamb

Three descriptions of the Lion who is a Lamb—

- A. The Lion earned the right to bring everything to a righteous end.
- B. The Lamb, by standing, affirms that the life of sacrifice for God is more than noble.
- C. The Lamb completed the re-creative work of God in which the faithful will live forever and ever.
