Sermon: “Admonitions of the Savior” (1)

Text: Isaiah 51:1-23

Introduction: We are continuing in our expositional journey through the book of Isaiah. We have for some time now been unfolding the fourth major division of the book in chapters 40-55 which we have dubbed “The Comfort of the Gospel”. Within these chapters we find nine specific comforts. We are now trafficking in the ninth of these nine comforts of the gospel

IX. The comfort of the Savior (49-55). In these chapters we will uncover at least 8 distinct truths about the “Servant of the Lord” – the Savior – the Lord Jesus Christ. The first three truths were:

- A. The incarnation of the Savior (49:1-7)
- B. The work of the Savior (49:8-26)
- C. The obedience of the Savior (51:1-11)
