Sermon: "The Sacrifice of the Savior" (2)

Text: Isaiah 52:13 – 53:12

**Introduction:** We have come to the ninth comfort which we have entitled:

IX. The comfort of the Savior (49-55). We are in the process of unfolding eight essential truths that parse out this specific comfort:

- A. The incarnation of the Savior (49:1-7)
- B. The Work of the Savior(49:8-26)
- C. The obedience of the Savior (50:1-11)
- D. The admonitions of the Savior (51:1-23)
- E. The publishing of salvation by the Savior (52:1-12)

And now we must consider the sixth essential truth that highlights the comfort of the Savior. It is:

F. The sacrifice of the Savior (52:13-53:12) - these 15 verses contain at least four great gospel truths about this servant of the Lord upon which all of salvation hinges.
