Text: Matthew 10:5-15

Introduction: Once Jesus' Capernaum ministry had ended in 8:34, Jesus picks up where he left off way back in 4:23-25 because we read in 8:35 almost the exact same words we read in 4:23-25... about how Jesus went throughout all the cities and villages of Galilee preaching the gospel and healing diseases. We are examining four aspects to this dynamic of shared kingdom mission found in four pericopes to be found in this discourse. The first was:

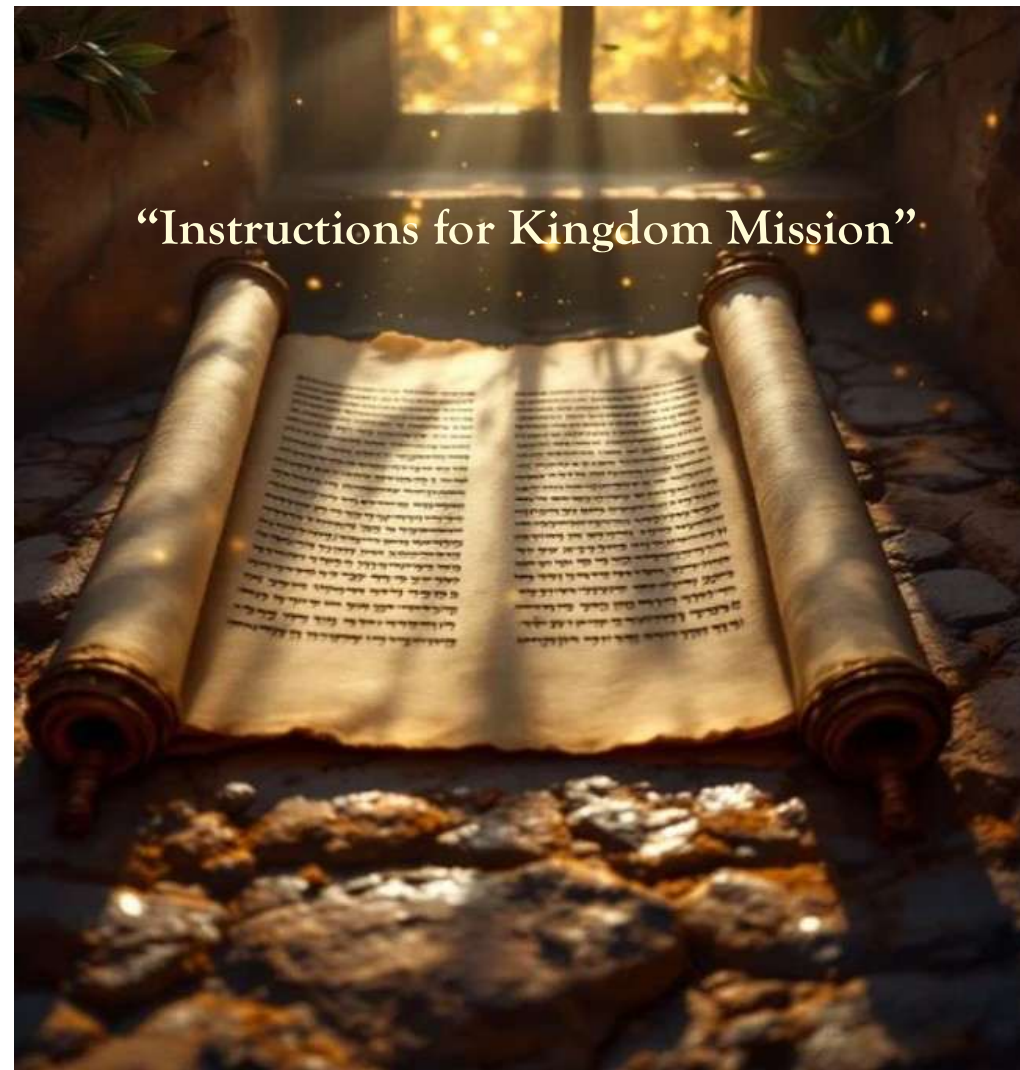
